

Dear Dodgeland School Families,

An increase in the number of identified COVID - 19 cases prompted a change in the Governor's school closure order. This afternoon, the district learned of a new order prohibiting the mass gathering of more than 50 people, which includes schools.

Therefore, **the Dodgeland School District will be closed beginning tomorrow, March 17 until Monday, April 13.** The return date may change depending upon the orders from the Governor. How will learning continue for my child?

We are hard at work revising our implementation plans. While we hoped to distribute iPads and learning packets in person on Tuesday, we now need to consider home delivery of these resources. It is our plan to complete the delivery of all learning resources by the end of this week.

How will my child (who is in 3rd through 12th grade) access the online resources?

We realize utilizing online resources is different for you and your child. We plan to include information, such as videos and printed directions, for accessing the BlueJeans learning platform with the delivery of their technology.
