- THE IN-TOWN BUS STOPS IN JUNEAU WILL CONTINUE TO RUN AT THE DOLLAR
 GENERAL STOP AND THE LIBRARY STOP. IN ORDER FOR YOUR STUDENT TO RIDE
 THE BUS FOR THESE STOPS, YOU MUST SIGN UP YOUR CHILD WITH THE BUS
 COMPANY, LAMERS. THEIR PHONE NUMBER IS (920) 386-2200, EXTENSION 11412.
 IF YOUR CHILD IS NOT ON THEIR BUS LIST. THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RIDE.
- COMMUNICATION WITH LAMERS BUS COMPANY JOEL SCHAALMA OR YVONNE BACON - IS VERY IMPORTANT SO THAT ROUTES REMAIN ON SCHEDULE THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL YEAR.
- IF YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE RIDING THE BUS FOR ANY REASON, PLEASE CALL 920-386-2200 EXTENSION 11411 OR 11412 AND LEAVE A DETAILED MESSAGE BEFORE 6:30 AM.
- PICK UP OR DROP OFF TO LOCATIONS OTHER THAN THE CHILD'S HOME ARE
 PERMITTED ONLY FOR SUPERVISION OR DAYCARE PURPOSES. THESE
 ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE MADE IN ADVANCE WITH THE BUS COMPANY MANAGER
 OR BUS COMPANY OFFICE ASSISTANT.
- PARENTS MUST TRANSPORT ANY FRIENDS GOING TO SOMEONE'S HOME OR FOR A
 SLEEPOVER. THE LAMERS BUS DRIVERS WILL NOT TRANSPORT OTHER STUDENTS
 NOT ASSIGNED TO THEIR ROUTE. BUSES DO NOT HAVE THE CAPACITY TO
 TRANSPORT EXTRA RIDERS. DODGELAND ADMINISTRATORS AND OFFICE
 PERSONNEL WILL NOT BE APPROVING ANY BUS REQUESTS EVERYTHING GOES
 THROUGH LAMERS.
- ALL STUDENTS WILL HAVE AN ASSIGNED SEAT ON THE BUS. FOR SAFETY
 REASONS, AS WELL AS TO ENCOURAGE SUCCESSFUL BUS TRIPS, STUDENTS MUST
 SIT IN THIS SEAT AT ALL TIMES.
- IF YOU HAVE A STUDENT RIDING THE EC/4K BUS, THERE MUST BE AN ADULT AT THE STOP FOR THE DRIVER TO HAND THE STUDENT OFF TO. IF NO ONE IS THERE, THE CHILD WILL REMAIN ON THE BUS WHILE THE ROUTE CONTINUES UNTIL A PARENT CAN BE NOTIFIED.

WALKING OR RIDING A BIKE TO SCHOOL?

HANDBOOK CHANGE

RELEASE FROM SCHOOL- -APPOINTMENTS DURING SCHOOL DAY

WE ENCOURAGE PARENTS TO MAKE MEDICAL AND DENTAL APPOINTMENTS AFTER SCHOOL HOURS SO AS NOT TO INTERRUPT LEARNING. IF YOUR CHILD DOES NEED TO LEAVE THE BUILDING DURING THE SCHOOL DAY, PLEASE COME INTO THE OFFICE TO GET HIM/HER AND TO SIGN HIM/HER OUT.THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY OF THE CHILD. IT IS OUR WAY OF KNOWING THAT THE CHILD HAS LEFT THE SCHOOL WITH THE PROPER PERSON.

** NEW: PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY WHEN COMING TO PICK YOUR CHILD UP FOR AN APPOINTMENT. WHEN YOU ARRIVE, WE WILL CALL THE CLASSROOM TO NOTIFY THEM THAT AN ADULT IS PRESENT TO PICK THEM UP. THIS WAY WE CAN MAXIMIZE THE AMOUNT OF TIME YOUR CHILD IS LEARNING IN THE CLASSROOM. THIS MEANS THAT IT MAY TAKE 3-5 MINUTES AFTER YOU ARRIVE, BEFORE YOUR CHILD IS IN THE OFFICE TO BE SIGNED OUT. ALSO, SEND A NOTE OR MESSAGE AHEAD OF TIME TO THE CLASSROOM TEACHER THROUGH EMAIL, TEXT, CLASS DOJO OR WRITTEN NOTE.

A CHILD RETURNING TO SCHOOL FROM AN APPOINTMENT NEEDS TO BE CHECKED INTO THE OFFICE WITH A NOTE FOR OUR DOCUMENTATION TO ASSIST WITH MAINTAINING ACCURATE ATTENDANCE RECORDS. THIS NOTE DOES NEED TO BE ON LETTERHEAD OR OTHER MEANS FROM WHICH YOUR CHILD HAD THEIR APPOINTMENT.









Help Your Child Succeed in School: Build the Habit of Good Attendance Early

DID YOU KNOW?


- Starting in preschool and kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school.
- Missing 10%, or about 2 days each month over the course of a school year, can make it harder to learn to read.
- Students can still fall behind if they miss just one or two days every few weeks.
- Being late to school may lead to poor attendance.
- Absences and tardiness can affect the whole classroom if the teacher has to slow down learning to help children catch up.

Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school—and themselves. Start building this habit in preschool so they learn right away that going to school on time, every day is important. Eventually good attendance will be a skill that will help them succeed in high school and college.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

- Set a regular bedtime and morning routine.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Keep your child healthy and make sure your child has the required shots.
- Introduce your children to their teachers and classmates before school starts.
- Develop backup plans for getting to school if something comes up. Call on a family member, a neighbor, or another parent.
- Try to schedule non-urgent related medical appointments and extended trips when school isn't in session.
- If your child seems anxious about going to school, talk to teachers, school counselors and other parents for advice on how to make your child feel comfortable and excited about learning.
- If you are concerned that your child may have a contagious illness, call your school or health care provider for advice.
- If your child must stay home due to illness, ask the teacher for resources and ideas to continue learning at home.


