
FACE COVERING MANDATE




- Per Trailways Conference order, all spectators at INDOOR events will be REQUIRED to wear a face covering during the entire fall sports season.
- Governor's face covering mandate has also been extended through the fall sports season - to Nov. 21st.
- We also ask that every OUTDOOR spectator wear a face covering at events to demonstrate support for our athletes and their season. Help us keep our seasons going!!

DODGELAND SPECTATOR LIMITS

- Dodgeland will allow **TWO family member spectators per athlete** to attend our home events.
- No admission will be charged and no concessions sold.
- Bleacher seating will be designated locations with signs to ensure social distancing of 6 feet between the pairs of spectators.
- **No student spectators** will be permitted at any events.



HOME SPECTATOR ADMISSION TICKETS



- Dodgeland will be providing **TWO family admission tickets** to each Dodgeland student-athlete 1-2 days prior to a home event so please ask your child for the two tickets when they arrive home.
- Family spectators attending an event must print their name on the ticket.
- Admission tickets will be collected at each home event by a school representative. Admission will be denied if no admission ticket is presented.
- Volleyball admission tickets will be collect at the MS/HS entrance - door 6.
- Football admission tickets will be collected at the stadium entrance.
- Soccer admission tickets will be collected at the Wild Goose Park entrance.
- Tickets are collected & kept in the event contact tracing is necessary by Dodge County Department of Public Health.

DODGELAND SPECTATOR EXPECTATIONS

- Separate home and visitor areas will be designated.
- Intermingling among spectators is **PROHIBITED.**
- Once seated, spectators must remain in their seats.
 - Only exceptions include:
 - Bathroom use
 - Exiting the event
 - Emergencies



LIVE STREAMING / RECORDED EVENTS



- The Dodgeland School District will be live streaming as many athletic events possible - for FREE via YouTube with the link available on our website and FaceBook page.
- Order of live streaming will be prioritized in this order:
 - Varsity - JV - MS events
- The Dodgeland School District will be recording as many events as possible that could not be live streamed with the video link available on our website and FaceBook page.

FAMILY SPECTATOR INFORMATION

PRE-GAME EXPECTATIONS - ALL SPECTATORS



1. Pre-screen for symptoms before leaving your home.
2. INDOOR Events - Face coverings must be worn at all times.
3. OUTDOOR Events - we ask that every OUTDOOR spectator wear a face covering at events to demonstrate support for our athletes and their season. Help us keep our seasons going by wearing a face covering!!
4. Sanitize hands upon entrance into the competition area.
5. Follow signs to the event seating - direct walking route required. Sit in correct designated areas and be socially distanced from others.

**** Refusal to follow event expectations will result in removal from the event. ****


DURING GAME EXPECTATIONS - ALL SPECTATORS

1. Face coverings remain on INDOOR EVENTS - covering both mouth & nose.
2. OUTDOOR Events - we ask that every OUTDOOR spectator wear a face covering at events to demonstrate support for our athletes and their season. Help us keep our seasons going by wearing a face covering!!
3. Remain at your seat for the duration of the event.
4. Limit bathroom use to emergency use only - limited access.
5. Follow travel route if necessary to leave before event ends.
6. No re-entry to the event permitted once a spectator has left.



Support all players, coaches and officials through positive displays of sportsmanship!

POST GAME EXPECTATIONS - ALL SPECTATORS



1. Spectators will be dismissed in a staggered manner to maintain social distancing. Remain in your seats until released by event personnel.
2. No pictures or congregating on the court or field will be permitted,
3. Sanitize hands before leaving the event.
4. Parents must return to their vehicle and wait for their child to exit the event.
5. No re-entry to the event permitted once a spectator has left.
6. Face coverings may be removed once outside and socially distanced from others exiting an indoor the event.
