
Middle School Forensics Competitors Qualify for State!

3K and 4K Screening

April 19th and 20th

Dodgeland 3K and 4K Registration for the 2023-2024 school year is OPEN! Children who live in district who are 2 1/2 or 3 years old whose parents or caregivers have concerns regarding speech or developmental delays are encouraged to sign up for a time to meet with our early childhood team during the event. If your child is 3 or 4 years old by September 1st, they are eligible to join our 3K or 4K program. This year we will be returning to our in-person screening process for students to see a classroom, for parents to ask questions, and to complete registration materials for the fall. - Consistent 2-day (T/TH), 3-day (M/W/F), or 5-day options
 - » 2-day option: \$15/day (\$1065/year)
 - » 3-day option: \$12/day (\$1260/year)
 - » 5-day option: \$10/day (\$1760/year)
- Wraparound Care is available (\$5/hr)
 - » 6:30am 7:30am
 - » 11:00am 5:45pm
- Transportation is NOT provided
- Toilet Training not required

Dodgeland 4K Program

Play-Based 4K program from 8am - 3am

- Follows our Dodgeland School district calendar
- Consistent 4-day (M TH) or 5-day option
- Wraparound Care is available (\$5/hr)
 - » 6:30am 7:30am
 - » 11:00am 5:45pm
- Transportation provided on regular district bus routes
- Toilet Training not required
- One-time yearly School Fee: \$25
- Weekly access to art, music, PE, guidance and library lessons.


Support for Mental Health

In January we asked for parent input on a mental health survey. From that survey, we learned:

- 90% of parents think about their child's mental health often
- 81% say their child has good/excellent mental health now (when completing the survey)
- 60% say they are concerned about their child's mental health
- Parents would prefer to watch a recorded session vs an in person event to learn about mental health topics

Supporting the overall well-being of students is important to our work at Dodgeland. With our mental health grant funds, we are excited to be able to offer Care Solace as a support available to all families in need of finding mental health support. Academic Decathlon is a nationwide program dedicated to academic excellence in high schools. Academic Decathlon provides students of all learning levels the opportunity to excel academically through team competition. The Academic Decathlon is a team competition where students match their intellects with students from other schools. Essentially, they study to take tests for fun while competing against other teams. Students are tested in ten categories: art, economics, essay, interview, language and literature, mathematics, music, science, social science, and speech. All content is aligned with the yearly theme; this year's theme is the American Revolution.
