## Supporting Students in Transition

THE DODGELAND SCHOOL DISTRICT IS COMMITTED TO SUPPORTING STUDENTS AND FAMILIES EXPERIENCING HOUSING INSTABILITY. UNDER THE **MCKINNEY-VENTO ACT**, FAMILIES OR UNACCOMPANIED YOUTH IN TEMPORARY LIVING SITUATIONS **MAY QUALIFY** FOR ADDITIONAL EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT.

### WHO QUALIFIES?

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR SUPPORT IF YOU ARE LIVING IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

- **DOUBLED UP:** LIVING WITH FRIENDS OR RELATIVES DUE TO ECONOMIC HARDSHIP.
- **SHELTERED:** LIVING IN AN EMERGENCY OR TRANSITIONAL SHELTER.
- **TEMPORARY:** LIVING IN A MOTEL, HOTEL, CAR, OR CAMPSITE.
- **SUBSTANDARD:** LIVING IN A HOME WITHOUT UTILITIES (WATER, HEAT, OR ELECTRICITY).
- **UNACCOMPANIED:** STUDENTS LIVING WITH SOMEONE WHO IS NOT A LEGAL GUARDIAN.

### AVAILABLE RESOURCES

IF YOU QUALIFY, THE DISTRICT CAN PROVIDE ASSISTANCE WITH:

- **SCHOOL STABILITY:** STAYING IN YOUR CURRENT SCHOOL DURING AND AFTER A MOVE.
- **ENROLLMENT:** WAIVED SCHOOL FEES AND SIMPLIFIED REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS.
- **NUTRITION & SUPPLIES:** FREE SCHOOL MEALS AND NECESSARY SCHOOL SUPPLIES.
- **TRANSPORTATION:** ASSISTANCE WITH BUSING OR GAS CARDS TO GET TO SCHOOL.




