
FACE COVERING MANDATE




- **Per Trailways Conference order, all spectators at winter events will be REQUIRED to wear a face covering during the entire winter sports season.**
- The Governor's face covering mandate also requires everyone to wear a face covering.
- Our student-athletes are grateful for the opportunity to compete in winter sports. Help us keep our seasons going by wearing your face covering correctly at all times and maintaining social distancing at all events!!

DODGELAND SPECTATOR LIMITS

- Dodgeland will allow **TWO family member spectators per athlete** to attend our middle and high school home events.
- No admission will be charged and no concessions sold.
- Bleachers will have signs with designated seating to ensure social distancing of 6 feet occurs between the pairs of spectators.
- **No student sections or students sitting together** will be permitted at any events.



SPECTATOR ADMISSION TICKETS



- Dodgeland will be providing **TWO family admission tickets** to each Dodgeland student-athlete 1-2 days prior to a home event so please ask your child for the two tickets when they arrive home.
- Visitor spectator tickets will be printed and distributed by each school's athletic director 1-2 days prior to the event at Dodgeland.
- **Family spectators attending an event must print their name on the ticket - please do this before arriving to the event.**
- Admission tickets will be collected at the school entrance for every middle and high school home event by a school representative. Admission will be denied if no admission ticket is presented.
- Use of hand sanitizer is also expected when entering our school.
- Tickets are collected & kept in the event contact tracing is necessary by Dodge County Department of Public Health.

DODGELAND SPECTATOR EXPECTATIONS

- Separate home and visitor seating areas will be designated.
- Intermingling among spectators is **PROHIBITED** - maintain safe social distancing at all times.
- Separation between athletes, coaches and spectators is also required.
- Once seated, spectators must remain in their seats.
 - Only exceptions include:
 - Bathroom use
 - Exiting the event
 - Emergencies



LIVE STREAMING / RECORDED EVENTS



- The Dodgeland School District will be live streaming all middle and high school home games for **FREE via YouTube.**
- Event links will be available on our website and Facebook page if needed. Otherwise, go to YouTube, search for Dodgeland and select the event you want to watch. Be sure to share this information with your family and friends!
- All events are recorded and available for viewing after games conclude. Enjoy!

WINTER SPECTATOR INFORMATION

PRE-GAME EXPECTATIONS - ALL SPECTATORS



1. Pre-screen for symptoms before leaving your home.
2. **Face coverings must be worn at all times over both the mouth and nose per the Trailways Conference COVID safety requirements and the governor's face covering mandate.**
3. Sanitize hands upon entrance into the competition area.
4. Follow signs to event seating - direct walking route required. Sit in correct designated spots, socially distanced from others and remain in your seats during the entire game.
5. Parents should attend only their own child's game and arrive about 10 minutes before the event is scheduled to start.
6. No admission is charged and no concessions will be sold.

**** Refusal to follow event expectations will result in removal from the gymnasium and school. ****


DURING GAME EXPECTATIONS - ALL SPECTATORS

1. Face coverings must be correctly worn at all times - covering both mouth & nose. Help keep our events safe for everyone!
2. Remain at your seat and socially distanced from others for the duration of the game.
3. Limit bathroom use to emergency use only.
4. Make a direct exit to our school's front doors if necessary to leave before a game ends.
5. No re-entry to the event permitted once a spectator has left.
6. No spectators permitted at team benches or in our locker room hallway.



Support all players, coaches and officials through positive displays of sportsmanship!

POST GAME EXPECTATIONS - ALL SPECTATORS



1. Spectators will exit the gym and school in a staggered manner, maintaining social distancing as soon as a game concludes.
2. No pictures, congregating on the court or meeting with players or coaches will be permitted,
3. Sanitize hands before leaving the event.
4. Parents must return to their vehicle and wait for their child to exit the event - no waiting for them in the gym or school.
5. No re-entry to the school permitted once a spectator has left.
6. Face coverings may be removed once outside and socially distanced from others exiting the event.
