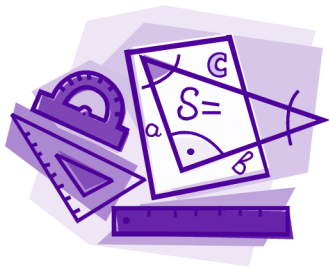


Participation in certified, caring mental health care is vital to student success.

For families who live in rural school districts, access to appropriate, certified counseling and therapy may not be an option. This is especially true if the distance to the counseling office requires time off from work for parents and time away from school for the students.

Working in conjunction with Dodge County rural school districts, the Dodge County Human Services and Health Department offers access to a state licensed, certified mental health and addictions therapies in a school-based office.

Managing the symptoms of mental illness improves school functioning.

There are many priorities competing for a child's attention while they are in school. Attending appointments for mental health care shouldn't be one of those priorities that takes a child away from classes.

Access to services and the time away from school to attend appointments shouldn't be barriers to getting the

care a student needs.

By offering mental health services in the schools, parents and students have easier access to care with less interference in the most important function in a child's life—attending school.

The services provided in the schools operate independently from the school district, and do not provide on-site crisis management or crisis intervention.

All appointment will be pre-scheduled; walk-in appointments are not available.

WHAT SERVICES ARE OFFERED?

- Initial assessment
- Treatment Planning
- Onsite, one-on-one counseling located in local Dodge County schools
- Referral to community resources
- Access to psychiatric care

HOW ARE THE SERVICES PAID FOR?

The Open Door counseling services provided through the Clinical Services Unit in the Dodge County Human Services and Health Department can be covered by Medicaid and most private insurance plans. Self-pay on a sliding-fee scale is also available. No student will be turned away based on the ability or inability to pay for the services.
