Dear Parent(s) / Guardian(s),

The Dodgeland School District is excited and pleased to provide a variety of Summer School courses this year. Remedial classes that are intended for students to continue to build/maintain their reading/math skills for the next grade; along with a wide variety of enrichment classes of interest to all students. Hopefully, there will be enough student interest in each course because a sufficient number of students are needed to run each class section. **Please note that classes are not guaranteed! If classes fill up, your child might be scheduled into an alternate class.**

Teachers will often recommend that a student enroll in Summer School to further develop the skills and abilities needed to carry on the work of the next grade. Parents are urged to give serious thought to such recommendations. Please note that some courses are given preference to students that are recommended for those courses.

Free breakfast and lunch will be provided to each summer school student. Each morning, students can choose a Take-and-Go breakfast starting at 7:35 to eat in their classrooms before school starts at 8am. Lunch will be served at the start of 4th period, and students will eat in their classrooms. (It is important that they indicate whether they are participating in the lunch program during the 1st period so enough lunches are prepared for all students.)

The Summer School program is open to any child entering 4K – 12th grade who resides within the boundaries of the Dodgeland School District, or is currently attending Dodgeland through open enrollment.

Online Registration begins on March 25, 2026 & Closes on May 20, 2026.

General Information

Registration: Fill out the online registration for 2026 summer school programming on PowerSchool in the parent portal. If you need a parent username/login, please contact the school at (920) 386-4404 ext 1000.

Course Fees: Driver's Education classroom course is free for students that reside within the Dodgeland School District or those enrolled in school choice (open-enrolled) at Dodgeland. The student fee for students outside the district is \$75. This is the classroom portion ONLY during summer school.

Program Location: All 4K -12th grade classes will be held in the Dodgeland School District building.

Breaks:

Students will be given a short “brain break” during classes as needed.

Dress:

Students are expected to follow the same standards of dress and conduct as those in effect during the school year. Please wear appropriate shoes for activity classes and sunblock for outdoor classes.

Transportation:

Bus transportation will be offered to and from Juneau during the session from June 3-July 2, 2026. Students will be picked up and dropped off at the following locations and times:

Students who are interested in attending just one class may do so, but transportation will not be provided separately. Example: if the class is held during the 1st period, the student could ride the bus to school; but would need to be picked up immediately after the 1st period ended. Or if the class isn't held until the 4th period, transportation would need to be provided to get the student here; but the student could ride the bus home.

Attendance:

- 1st -12th students enrolled in **enrichment** courses are encouraged to attend all classes.
- Any students enrolled in MS or HS **remedial** courses for the purpose of promotion/credit **must** attend all classes, except for illness or emergencies.

Conduct:

Any discipline problem may result in removal from class, and students may be dropped from the class. The following discipline procedure will be followed:

- 1st – Warning / Advisory
- 2nd – Suspension
- 3rd – Removal from summer school

Any student removed from class for discipline and/or attendance reasons will forfeit all fees. Middle school students will not move to the next grade level and high school students will not receive a passing grade.

Health/Emergency Information Sheet:

Parents will need to fill out questions during online registration regarding health/emergency information before their child/children can participate in summer school classes. We may need

to contact you or an emergency contact person regarding your child. There will not be a school nurse on site during the summer school session. However, minor medical triage will be available.

Cancellation Policy

Summer School will be canceled if there is a tornado watch or warning in the morning. School cancellations due to weather can be checked at the Dodgeland website, FaceBook, Dodgeland's Bright Arrow messaging program with text and/or email and local media outlets.

Before/After School Program (NEW IN 2026)

The Dodgeland Den will be open this summer for families that need care before or after summer school. The Den will open each morning at 6:30am and will dismiss students to their classes at 7:35am for the free breakfast. The Den will re-open at 12:30 when summer school ends and close at 5:30pm. The cost for parents will be \$5/hour/child during the summer school session (June 3-July 2, Mon-Thurs). Please sign up for Summer Dodgeland Den when you register for classes if you need childcare before/after summer school.

Summer Dodgeland Den (NEW IN 2026)

In addition to the Before/After School Den program during the summer school session (June 3-July 2, Mon-Thurs), Summer Dodgeland Den will be available for students (for a fee) for parents every Friday and from July 6-August 14 from 6:30am-5:30pm. This will be open to all students entering grades 4K through 6. Please sign up for Summer Dodgeland Den when you register for courses if you need childcare this summer. The cost for parents will be \$40/day/child for Summer Dodgeland Den.

Enrichment and Remedial Courses

Animals A-Z (for students entering Grades 1-2)

TBD

In this class, we will grab our passport and learn about animals on the seven continents! We will read, write, talk, and sing about animals. There will be many hands-on and creative animal activities!

***NEW* Business Build Up** (for students entering grades 4-6)

Ms. Tietz

Dive into the world of entrepreneurship in this “Shark Tank” inspired course! Students will use their math skills to design a product, manage a business budget, and calculate potential profits. The class culminates in a final pitch where young entrepreneurs present their business plans to a panel of “sharks.” It’s the perfect way to sharpen critical thinking and real-world math skills in a fun, competitive environment.

Board Games Galore - (for students entering Grades 1-3)

Do you like to play games! Well, come join us where that is all we do: learn, play, and experience new games! You can even bring any card, dice and/or board games from home to share and play if you want.

Drivers’ Ed (for students that will be 15 years old or older before next summer)

Mr. Miller

The classroom portion of Drivers’ education will take place during summer school from 8:00-12:30 in two sections: Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday section. Please sign up for the section that you prefer. At the conclusion of the course, you will take the written test for your Driver’s permit. See Mr. Miller’s letter for more information.

***NEW* Engineering Design** (for students entering grades 3-5, 6-8)

Mrs. Halverson

In this hands-on course, students transform from curious observers into active problem-solvers by tackling the "Big Three" of introductory engineering. Through the lens of **aerodynamics**, they will iterate on paper airplane designs to master lift and drag; in the **egg drop challenge**, they’ll explore impact stability and cushioning to protect their "payload" from gravity; and finally, they’ll dive into **structural engineering** by building bridges designed to span specific gaps and withstand heavy loads. It’s a week of "failing forward"—where testing, breaking, and refining lead to a deep understanding of how the physical world works.

Fantastic 4K (for students entering Grade 4K) (2 sections if needed)

Mrs. Wagner / Mrs. Ellefson (limit 16 students in each section)

This class will be one session – 8:00 AM – 12:30 PM. Students will meet in the classroom at the beginning of each school day when students arrive and go to breakfast as a group after attendance.

This class will let your soon-to-be 4K child dive into some summer fun. We will be reading many great books, creating projects, making new friends, and learning about how the 4K classroom works. Students need to bring a **paint shirt, a change of clothes in a labeled zip –lock bag, along with a daily snack and drink.**

Football FUNdamentals (for students entering Grades 5-8)

Students in this class will learn the fundamentals of football and have fun at the same time. Students will learn and practice skills together that will help for future football seasons.

Expectations for Driver Education

You may arrange a “swap” of a numbered lesson from A to B, or a B to an A, but it must be the same number to work. Please make these arrangements in advance if possible.

Example: You can't make B6, but you can make A6 that would not count as a miss. However, you may not swap a lesson 5 for a lesson 4 or 6.

You must pass the class assignments and test to successfully complete the course.
